We need to give our children well-defined sensory experiences to help them develop the above objectives.

Covington Co-op Preschool has a multisensory developmental approach by stimulating the five senses (sight, touch, hearing, smell, and taste) through creative activities based on children's interests and needs. We, as teachers of our children, will be providing a creative climate to develope a creative ability.

#### **CREATIVE CLIMATE IS:**

to stop the automatic NO

to defer from judgment

to allow the sharing of ideas to solve problems

### **CREATIVE ABILITY IS:**

to see things in a new or different way

to take risks

to not feel fearful of being wrong

Sensory Experiences form the base for development of abstract ideas.



To teach children too early so they learn by rote is to deprive them of the joy and excitement of meaningful discoveries. It fills their heads with things they know but to not understand.

#### I HEAR AND I FORGET - I SEE AND I REMEMBER - I DO AND I UNDERSTAND!

Of utmost importance in the early years of any child's life is the exposures and experiences that they receive in their everyday thinking. Parents are children's first teachers and can best help by giving them many, many different ways of exploring their world. They need to touch, see, hear, smell, taste, and ask questions.

#### WE NEED TO ENCOURAGE:

self motivation feelings of accomplishment a love of learning

The most natural way to accomplish all of this is through play and excursions with lots of speech and language. Children love to have fun, to explore, and to talk. Planned play activities help a child to practice skills that will lay a foundation for later learning. Also, by emphasizing the positive aspects of a child's performance, the youngster will build self-confidence and self-esteem, as well.

Mistakes should be generally minimized by not paying too much attention to them, it is more constructive to call attention to successes. A child responds favorably to positive reinforcement.
